Curriculum Information

English

Within English we will be looking at a book called Zeraffa Giraffa. This story links nicely to our science topic, Living Things. We will be looking at animals and their habitats. We will be focussing on sentence construction and making inferences from the text.

Maths

Over the next half-term, the children will be learning about numbers and place value. We will be becoming confident with numbers and practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be learning about addition and subtraction.

Topic (Science)

This half-term, our topic is 'Living Things'. During this topic, we will be leaning about living things and we will look at:

- Food chains
- Habitats
- Prey and predators

R.E.

We will be looking at 'Sacred Places' starting with thinking about places that are sacred (special) to us and then investigating different sacred places within different religions.

P.S.H.E.

During this half term, year 1 will look at making good choices and respect for one another.

Homework
