Curriculum Information

English

Our focus for English this half-term will be sentence construction, descriptive writing and punctuation. We will be reading "Gorilla" by Anthony Browne and "The Tin Forest" by Helen Ward and other texts linked to our "Bright Sparks" theme. Our reading focus will be identifying the different skills for reading comprehension.

Maths

Over the next half-term, the children will be learning about numbers and place value using numbers up to 1000. Our times table focus will be multiples of 3, 4 and 8. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, both mentally and in writing, using numbers with up to 3 digits. We will also use this knowledge to reason and to solve problems.

Topic (Science)

This half-term, our topic is 'Bright Sparks' which looks at electricity. During this topic, we will be applying our knowledge and skills:

- To research (using technology)
- To give reasons for particular events and changes
- To carry out investigations
- To plan, design and make products
- To develop our scientific skills

R.E.

We will be looking at what it means to be Jewish and why Christians follow the Bible.

P.S.H.E.

During this half term, year 3 will look at 'Dreams and Goals'.
